## 01 Lima City Tour

We will welcome you at the Lima airport and transfer you to your hotel so you can settle in comfortably. In the afternoon, we'll begin a fascinating City Tour, starting with a panoramic view of **Huaca Pucliana**, a pre-Inca ceremonial center from the 4th century, considered sacred by the **Incas.** 

The tour continues through Lima's Historic Center, home to more than fifty colonial-era monuments, including the **Paseo** de la República, Plaza San Martín, Plaza Mayor, the Government Palace, the Archbishop's Palace, the Cathedral Basilica, and the Municipal Palace.

Next, we'll visit the majestic San Francisco Monastery, an icon of colonial religious art in the Americas, renowned for its underground crypts known as the **Catacombs.** 

Finally, we'll explore modern Lima with a pleasant drive through its most traditional and sophisticated residential areas: **El Olivar de San Isidro**, the vibrant district of Miraflores, and the **Larcomar** shopping center, located on a stunning cliffside overlooking the Pacific Ocean.

### 02 | Paracas Huacachina

We begin our adventure at 5:00 a.m. with a pickup from your hotel in Lima. Around 9:00 a.m., we arrive in Paracas to enjoy a seaside breakfast. Then, we embark on a boat tour to the **Ballestas Islands,** where you'll marvel at dramatic rock formations and a rich marine wildlife, including Humboldt penguins, sea lions, and guano birds. On the way, we'll view the mysterious **Candelabra geoglyph**, whose origin remains a fascinating enigma.

Afterwards, we head to Ica for lunch among the vineyards at **Cultour Pisco**, where you'll savor traditional dishes. We then enjoy the **Pisco Tour**, learning about the artisanal production process from grape to distillation, with tastings of different varieties.

The day ends at the **Huacachina Oasis**, a natural lagoon surrounded by towering sand dunes, where you'll feel the thrill of a buggy ride and try sandboarding.

At the end of the day, we return to Lima and transfer you to your hotel for the night.

### 03 | City Tour Arequipa

At 9:00 a.m., the tour begins with hotel pickup. The first stop is the **Carmen Alto** viewpoint, offering a panoramic view of the Arequipa countryside and the three volcanoes that watch over the city: **Misti, Chachani, and Pichu Pichu.** 

Next, we visit the traditional district of **Yanahuara**, known for its charming plaza, colonial church, and alleyways built with the region's signature white sillar stone.

The tour continues toward the Historic Center of Arequipa, where we explore the **Main Square (Plaza de Armas)**, surrounded by elegant granite arcades. We also visit the **Neoclassical Basilica Cathedral,** featuring a 107-meterlong façade adorned with classical columns, symmetrical towers, and bronze medallions.

The journey then leads us to the Church and Cloisters of the **Society of Jesus**, a masterpiece of Baroque religious architecture founded in 1573.

The visit concludes at the iconic **Santa Catalina** Monastery, founded in 1580, a true city within a city that offers a glimpse into colonial monastic life.

## 04 Colca Valley

From the **Mirador de los Andes,** we will enjoy an impressive panoramic view of the Andes range, with sights of Mount Ampato where the famous mummy Juanita was found Mount Hualca-Hualca, and other majestic peaks.

Around midday, we will arrive at **Chivay**, a picturesque Andean village, where we will spend the night. In the afternoon, those who wish may take a walk around the area and relax at **La Calera** hot springs, surrounded by nature and mountains.

We'll then visit the charming towns of **Pinchollo, Yanque, and Maca**, where we'll discover pre-**Hispanic litho-sculptures**, **hanging tombs**, natural **amphitheaters**, colonial churches, and ancient agricultural terraces.

Around midday, we'll return to **Chivay** for lunch and a short rest. In the afternoon, we will begin our journey to Puno, arriving around 7:00 p.m., after crossing the highland landscapes of the Andes once again.

Enjoy an unforgettable experience sailing across the majestic **Lake Titicaca** on modern boats to visit two of its most iconic islands: **Uros and Taquile.** 

We will begin our journey with a visit to the floating **Uros Islands**, where you'll learn about the daily life of its inhabitants and have the opportunity to ride a traditional reed boat to admire the lake's beauty from a different perspective.



### 07 | Ruta del Sol Puno - Cusco

We will then cross the **La Raya Pass**, the highest point of the route, surrounded by stunning Andean landscapes and marking the natural border between Puno and Cusco.

At midday, we will enjoy a delicious buffet lunch before continuing to **Raqchi,** home to the majestic Temple of Wiracocha, one of the largest adobe structures from the lnca era.

Our last visit will be the **Chapel of Andahuaylillas**, often called the **"Sistine Chapel of the Americas,"** renowned for its baroque frescoes and magnificent religious art. After this enriching cultural day, we will arrive in Cusco, the legendary capital of the Inca Empire.

## 09 Cusco City Tour

Discover the rich history of Cusco on a fascinating tour through its main tourist attractions.



To conclude this leg of the journey, we'll transfer you to the train station in Ollantaytambo, where you'll board a panoramic train bound for **Aguas Calientes**, the charming town at the base of **Machu Picchu**. Upon arrival, you'll have time to relax and get ready for your highly anticipated visit to the Inca citadel the following day.

# 12 | Biking Adventure in Maras Moray

Around midday, we'll delight our taste buds with a traditional pachamanca in Ollantaytambo—an ancient Andean cooking technique where food is baked underground, creating unique and delicious flavors. After lunch, we'll return to Cusco.


