# 01 | Lima City Tour

We will welcome you at Lima's airport and transfer you to your hotel, where you can settle in comfortably. In the afternoon, we will begin a fascinating Lima City Tour, starting with a panoramic view of **Huaca Pucllana**, a pre-Inca ceremonial center from the 4th century, considered sacred by the Incas.

The tour continues through **Lima's Historic Center**, where you'll see over fifty colonial-era monuments, including the **Paseo de la República**, **San Martín Square**, **Main Square**, **Government Palace**, **Archbishop's Palace**, **Lima Cathedral**, and **City Hall**.

Next, we'll visit the majestic **San Francisco Monastery Complex**, an icon of colonial religious art in the Americas, famous for its underground crypts known as **the Catacombs**.

Finally, we'll explore modern Lima with a pleasant tour through its most traditional and sophisticated residential areas: **El Olivar in San Isidro**, the vibrant **district of Miraflores**, and the oceanfront shopping center **Larcomar**.

## 02 | Paracas Huacachina

We begin the adventure at 5:00 a.m. from your hotel in Lima. At 9:00 a.m., we arrive in Paracas to enjoy breakfast by the sea. Then, we embark on a boat trip to the **Ballestas Islands**, where you'll admire stunning rock formations and abundant marine wildlife, including Humboldt penguins, sea lions, and guano birds. Along the way, we'll also see the mysterious **Candelabra geoglyph**, whose history still fascinates visitors.

Afterwards, we continue to Ica to have lunch among **vineyards at Cultour Pisco**, savoring typical local dishes. Then, we take the Pisco Tour, discovering its artisanal process from grape to distillation and tasting various varieties.

The day ends in **Huacachina**, an oasis in the middle of the desert, where you'll experience the thrill of dune buggy rides and sandboarding. At the end of the day, we'll transfer you to the **glamping site** located among the dunes. You'll enjoy a cheese platter accompanied by a delicious dinner. Finally, you'll settle into your tent, equipped with all the comforts of a boutique hotel, for a restful night.

## 03 | Gastronomic Tour

To finish, you'll enjoy a traditional Peruvian lunch, which may include dishes like lomo saltado or ají de gallina, served with your homemade ceviche and a refreshing glass of chicha morada.

## 04 | Walking Tour in Cusco

At the agreed time, we will transfer you from your hotel in Lima to the airport, where you will take your flight to the city of Cusco. Upon arrival, our team will welcome you and escort you to your hotel so you can settle in comfortably.

In the afternoon, we will pick you up from your hotel and head to the top of **Cristo Blanco**, where you will enjoy an impressive panoramic view of the city. Next, we will visit the **Sapantiana Aqueduct** and stroll along the picturesque **Siete Borreguitos Street**, perfect for capturing memorable photos.

We will continue exploring the traditional **San Blas neighborhood**, with its narrow streets and artisan workshops, before reaching the iconic **Twelve-Angled Stone**. At the Plaza de Armas, a UNESCO World Heritage site, we will relive the Inca and colonial history of the city.

We will pass through **Espinar Square** and **Marqués Street**, finishing at the famous **San Pedro Market**, where you will experience local customs and enjoy the true essence of Cusco.

## 05 | Sacred Valley of the Incas

At 7:00 a.m., we will pick you up from your hotel for a journey of approximately one hour to **Pisac**, an archaeological site that showcases the advanced Inca engineering. Here, you will learn about their urban planning and agricultural terraces. Next, we will visit the Pisac artisan market, where you can find paintings, jewelry, textiles, and a variety of traditional crafts.

At midday, we will delight your palate with an authentic **pachamanca** in **Ollantaytambo**, an ancient Andean cooking technique that combines unique flavors cooked underground. Afterwards, we will visit the Ollantaytambo archaeological site, an impressive fortress with finely crafted stone walls, strategically built for astronomical and defensive purposes.

To conclude this part of the trip, we will transfer you to the Ollantaytambo train station, where you will board the panoramic train to **Aguas Calientes**, the charming town at the base of **Machu Picchu**. Once settled, you will have time to rest and prepare comfortably for the much-anticipated visit to the Inca citadel the next day.

## 08 | Maras - Moray

The Incas used its precisely designed circular terraces to improve crops and adapt them to different microclimates.

Next, we will head to **Maras**, the main salt supplier in the region. Here you will discover the ingenuity and skill of the Incas in extracting this mineral. Its more than **3,000 salt ponds**, used since pre-Inca times, create a spectacular landscape that seems out of this world.

After visiting and exploring these spectacular sites, our transport will pick you up and we will return to the city of Cusco, where our tour concludes around 2:00 p.m.
